

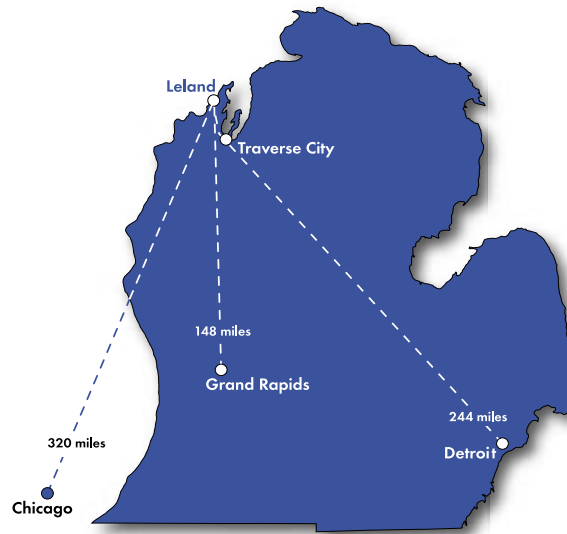

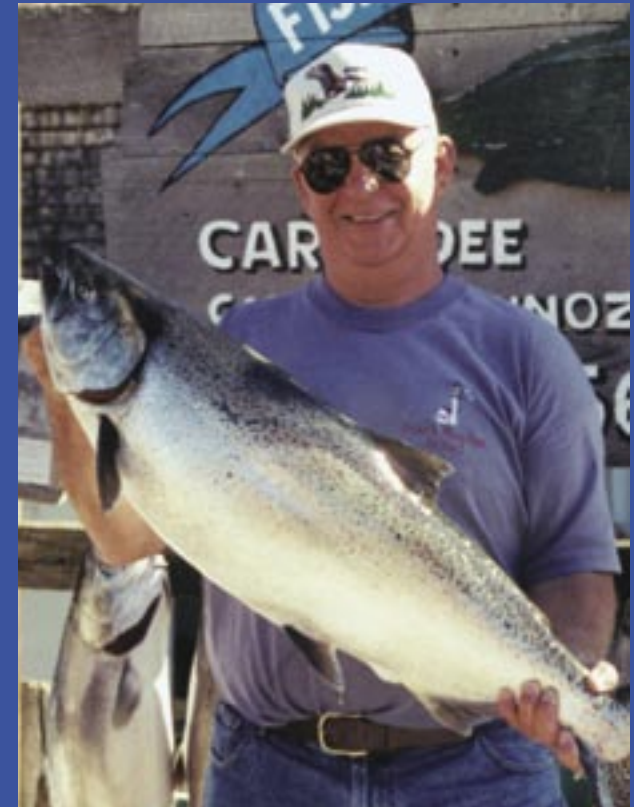
A current Michigan all-species fishing license is required for all charter clients.
